
### Lesson 22: Unstressed Ending -ant/-ent (continued)

**SPELLING CLUES: Mnemonics** A *mnemonic* device is a trick or strategy to help you remember something. You might, for example, remember that *immigrant* ends in -ant by making up a sentence such as "The immigrant came to this country." The *a* in came will remind you that *immigrant* ends in -ant.
